SCHLOSS LEOPOLDSKRON PALACE

Classically elegant – exclusively private

The palace in Leopoldskron is a wonderful source of inspiration. This rococo jewel has been preserved in its original splendour and is just a few minutes' walk from the old town of Salzburg in the Leopoldskron area. Prince Archbishop Leopold Anton von Firmian commissioned the building of the palace as a summer residence. It is embedded in the broader landscape of the palace park on the edge of Leopoldskroner Weiher lake.

The palace also rose to prominence as the birthplace of the world-famous Salzburg Festival. In fact, Max Reinhard - director and co-founder of the Salzburg Festival actually lived in Leopoldskron from 1918 until 1938. The palace later achieved international fame as one of the locations for the filming of 'The Sound of Music'.

For decades the estate has been under the private ownership of the US NPO Salzburg Global Seminar. It is primarily a global centre for dialogues and conferences, offering the options of in-house accommodation and the chance to utilise the venue for private festivities.
